

**COMPETITION RULES**  
**„OLIVERA DJURDJEVIC“**  
**INTERNATIONAL CHAMBER MUSIC COMPETITION**  
**Belgrade, March 15-16, 2025.**

**Article 1.**

The Elementary Music School „Vladimir Djurdjevic“ of Belgrade (Serbia) in collaboration with the Flute Association of Serbia „Miodrag Azanjac“, organize the **VI International Chamber Music Competition „Olivera Djurdjevic“.**

**Article 2.**

The event is addressed to students coming from public and private music schools/academies worldwide.

**Article 3.**

The competition will be held in the **Elementary Music School „Vladimir Djurdjevic“, V. Jagica 5, Belgrade (Serbia) from 15<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> of March, 2025.**

**Article 4.**

**COMPETITION PROPOSITIONS**

**Chamber ensembles of 2 up to 9 members** are entitled to participate in the Competition, including different combinations of instruments and voice, as well as piano duo.

Ensembles of all categories perform **free choice program**, in accordance with the given time limit and other requirements.

Categories and performance duration

**I category – younger grades of Elementary Music School (grades I-III for six-year education; grades I and II for four-year education) – up to 5 minutes**

**II category – older grades of Elementary Music School (grades IV-VI for six-year education; grades III and IV for four-year education) – up to 8 minutes**

**III category – grades I and II of Secondary Music School – up to 12 minutes**

**IV category – grades III and IV of Secondary Music School – up to 15 minutes**

Two or more pieces from different epochs.

**V category – Bachelor Studies and Master Studies – up to 20 minutes**

Two or more pieces from different epochs.

**VI category – Specialist Studies and Doctoral Studies – up to 20 minutes**

Two or more pieces from different epochs.

Note: Category is determined based on the ensemble member with the highest level of education.

### **Article 5.**

To enter the competition, ensembles will have to complete the required **online application form**, given at the official School website [www.vladimirdjordjevic.edu.rs](http://www.vladimirdjordjevic.edu.rs)

On the day of the Competition, ensemble members have to show evidence of school/faculty enrollment, as well as copy of the payment receipt for the registration fee (showing ensemble name) to the Competition secretary.

### **Article 6.**

APPLICATION DEADLINE – **February 21, 2025.**



### **Article 7.**

#### **Registration (Donation) Fees**

**Duo (all categories) – 5.000 RSD.**

**Trio (all categories) – 6.000 RSD.**

**Chamber ensembles of 4 up to 9 members (all categories) – 7.000 RSD**

**Ensembles from other countries** should pay their donations when they arrive to Serbia (on the day of Competition).

**Ensembles from EMS „Vladimir Djordjevic“ Belgrade** pay half-price.

All donations must be paid to Bank Account of the Flute Association of Serbia, account number: **205-65542-81**, purpose of payment: **„Donation for chamber music competition“**.

In the case of candidates' cancellation, the Organizer is not obliged to return the fee payment.

### **Article 8.**

#### Prizes

**1st prize: 95 – 100 points**

**2nd prize: 85 – 94.99 points**

**3rd prize: 75 – 84.99 points**

**Acknowledgement: 70 – 74.99 points**



In case that two or more ensembles obtain the same number of points, jury reserves the right to determine ensembles' placement.

**In each category** with more than one competing ensemble, the ensemble obtaining the highest score (and minimum 95 points), will be awarded with a prize named **Laureate of the Category.**

Among I and II category Laureates, jury determines **one ensemble**, to be awarded with a special prize – **Elementary Music School Laureate.**

Among III and IV category Laureates, jury determines **one ensemble**, to be awarded with a special prize – **Secondary Music School Laureate.**

Among V and VI category Laureates, jury determines **one ensemble**, to be awarded with a special prize – ***Academic Level Laureate***.

In addition to diploma, Laureates may be awarded by cup, as well as other gifts provided by competition's sponsors. Additional awards and gifts are subject to change without notice.

**Article 9.**

Some of the winners of the first prizes of each category may participate in the final concert, open to the public, and will execute the pieces chosen by the jury.

**Article 10.**

The **Jury** of Competition will comprise of outstanding Serbian and foreign music pedagogists, whose names will be announced on our web site one month before the start of the Competiton.

**Article 11.**

Travel expenses, board and lodging are at the candidates charge.

**Article 12.**

The organizer reserves the right to acquire and publish audiovisual material during the Competition, without any compensation for the participants.

**Article 13.**

The organizer is not responsible for any risks, injuries or damages of any kind suffered by participants during the event.
